

Olmsted SWCD implements their annual tree program each spring, selling and distributing trees to landowners promoting conservation planting. In addition, District staff provides year round information and technical assistance to landowners for species selection and design for establishing shelterbelts, windbreaks, living screens in urban areas, and wildlife plantings. The program also offers clients the option to promote the growth of the young trees they have purchased by making available weed barrier tree mats, tube type tree shelters, and fertilizer.
