**MATERNAL EDUCATION**

43% no HS diploma or GED  
 41% HS diploma or GED  
 26% some post-secondary or degree



**MATERNAL RACE/ETHNICITY**

67% White                      25% Black  
 5% Asian                        29% Hispanic



**PRENATAL CARE**

83% of women who were referred to HCF in 1<sup>st</sup> trimester received prenatal care in the 1<sup>st</sup> trimester



**OUT-OF-WEDLOCK BIRTHS**

56% of births were to unmarried women



**SMOKING**

32% of pregnant women smoked during pregnancy



**POSTPARTUM DEPRESSION SCREENING**

84% screened for postpartum depression



**BREASTFEEDING**

81% of those who breastfed, breastfed 6+ months



**SUBSEQUENT PREGNANCY**

78% no subsequent pregnancy at 24 months postpartum



**BIRTHS**

64 births  
 13% teen births



**PREMATURITY**

8% of infants were born at least 3 weeks too early



**LOW BIRTH WEIGHT**

6% of infants were born weighing less than 5.5 pounds



**FIRST TIME MOMS**

52% first time moms



**HOME SAFETY CHECK LIST**

92% completed



**ER/URGENT CARE VISITS**

7% had 1 or more visits due to injury



**DEVELOPMENTAL MILESTONES**

92% met developmental milestones



**SOCIAL-EMOTIONAL MILESTONES**

92% met social-emotional milestones



**CHILD MALTREATMENT**

2% of children experienced substantiated maltreatment
