i. 2017 Results – how budgets will move forward to 2018

1. Still some tweaking to do on both. First year we have had two year grant, have two years to spend the budget. 1<sup>st</sup> year up to 50% but can underspend.
2. Behind on invoices on Olmsted and Hiawatha side. Underspent on training which can be carried over.
3. Candace will reach out to those who are underspent. Final budget in next week or two.

ii. Budget modifications going forward

1. Still working on budget amendments to send to the state.
2. Mobile Crisis grant, still needing contract signed for 2018.
  - a. \$625 K for 2018 and have applied for innovation grant, awaiting word on this.

- iv. DHS Updates
  - 1. A lot of reshuffling going on so unsure if we will have a new representative. Now position in MH Intensive Services Supervisor is on the DHS website.
  - 2. Changes on BRASS Codes contact Courtney Jones for these questions.
  - 3. Peer Specialist Training for 2018, 14 people. Peerslinktohope.org.
  - 4. Government Task Force on housing asking about housing priorities. mnhousingtaskforce.com
- v. Regional Coordinator Position
  - 1. Tim Hunter from Wabasha is going to be starting on February 5<sup>th</sup>, last day is February 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- vi. Mobile Crisis Grant update
  - 1. Luke has accepted a position with Olmsted County to replace Carla Hammond.
  - 2. 1800 phone calls in 2017
  - 3. 358 face to face mobile assessments 106% increase
  - 4. Crisis stabilization certified 13 face to face appts.
  - 5. MH innovation grant, Luke working to have conversations with stakeholders for funding opportunities and also checking with county directors.
  - 6. Have not signed the contract at this time because funding is only set to last through August.
- vii. Crisis Center update
  - 1. No new updates but there are meetings on the calendar, the meeting did get cancelled this month.
- viii. Approve per diems (\$25 per meeting) and mileage rate (2018 rate = \$.545)
  - 1. This information is in the bi-laws
    - a. Motion to approve mileage rate and then was seconded
    - b. This allows for the chair and vice-chair to get mileage reimbursed for other meetings outside of CREST safety net meeting.
- ix. County Updates
  - 1. Fillmore- Community support program going to have two therapists on Tuesdays now as oppose to one.

2. Winona- New Director started. No staff openings, covering child and family services since that supervisor is out.
3. Olmsted- Two new employees as stated above
  - a. SU Reform, gearing up for this. Olmsted and Dakota along with DHS and Washington County are starting talks about what business might look like when reform takes place. What will services look like at county level?
  - b. DHS has offered to come down to Southeast MN to look at what options we can come up with for services. Wabasha and Winona said that when they met with them there are a lot of unanswered questions.
  - c. Law enforcement liaison position will ride along with LE at some of the CIT contacts, collaborate with mobile crisis, hospitals, has to be a MH professional or licensee.
4. Mobile Crisis Steering Committee next time is suspended until new coordinator hired
5. Hiawatha Valley- Support staff from main office to new location, waiting on sale of property. Innovation grant peer support network drop in center.
6. Wabasha- Hiring for Tim's position
7. ZVMHC- Continuing to look for psychiatric providers they have three but looking to expand. Expanded primary care office hours. Other positions are open as well.
8. Goodhue- Struggling to keep up with R20 evaluations when people are not competent. County board looking at plan for the ANOKA costs. One commissioner interested in opiates and the epidemic. AMC Award Healthy Pathways
9. IMS Services- Explained their services and what counties they serve. New programs- OP CD Program in Albert Lea, Certified DBT. Hiring for an ARMHS practitioner and case manager. New director behavioral health started on Monday.
10. Micah Bare (sp?) (UCARE) Program Policy Coordinator- attending to get update from counties. Behavioral Health Liaison also attended. Some prior authorization requirements have been made a bit easier.
