1. Welcome/Introductions
2. Meeting Minutes approval
 - a. Karen and Abby made motions, minutes approved
3. Budget Update
 - a. 2017 Results – how budgets will move forward to 2018
 - i. AMHI- Underspent in 2017, training was part of it. This is a two year budget, cannot overspend by 50% of the two year budget in the first year. Underspent \$93k, this was carried forward to 2018. Second page of sheet is the new budget that needs to be spent by the end of 2018
 - ii. Mobile Crisis Grant- Underspent by \$40k and cannot carryover. Roughly 5% was not spent. Have not received other monies yet so this will be a constant change.
 - b. Budget modifications going forward
 - i. DHS gave us a 50% leeway and now they want everything if there are any changes. This will be reported twice annually, July and December.
4. Strategic Plan 2017-2019
 - a. Housing forum
 - i. Looking at developing a forum for housing services, what are best practices etc. get everyone in a room and have DHS lead this conversation. Want to have a resource center created, barrier could be DHS because of their positions being defined. How do we bring AMH case managers together to network re: best practices? What topics do case managers want to know more about?
 - b. Peer Support Specialists
 - i. Where are we with peer support specialists? Do we have space to do other trainings? DHS looking to do more trainings.

- ii. SCHRC- 4 -2 at IRTS, 1 ACT Team, 1 other, ZVHC- 1 @IRTS, 1 Fillmore, 1 in ARMHS, 1 in house as recovery specialist- still defining this position could be Rule 31 (245G) requirement.
- 5. LAC involvement
 - a. Representatives for CREST
 - i. What is happening in region, how we support them, want a rep from each to come twice a year and report back about what they have been doing. Getting more consumers at the table and involved. Also going to have them involved with the housing forum discussion. SCHRC will have a housing services forum at the Local Mental Health Meeting. All counties do not have an active LAC. Courtney Lawson-NAMI had people call with interest in Olmsted.
 - ii. LAC- What is it all about? Then Active Minds and IPS service. Winona St. students doing a community assessment re: MH. Updates, MH day on the hill.
- 6. Legislative Proposals (Crisis Center and Supportive Housing)
 - a. Crisis Center
 - i. What benefits does this have SE MN? Identified population and services under this roof. Not an emergency more urgent care. Divert from IP ED bed but not send them home.
 - ii. MACSSA and AMC have both of these as priorities for legislative session.
 - iii. Charity MNPrairie Courtney Lawson spoke at Mayo re: this.
 - iv. Peer support and stabilization serving children and adults.
 - b. Supportive Housing
 - i. Creating a facility to do a couple of things
 - 1. Add more beds (Youngdahl, Hiawatha Bluffs model)
 - 2. Unit for individuals coming out of AMRTC that DNMC
 - a. What do these services look like?
 - ii. Senate budget committee came through Hiawatha Bluffs as well.
- 7. DHS- AMHI ITV
 - a. Spoke about certified peer updates
 - i. Changes-
 - 1. No longer need to have a high school diploma to be a PSS
 - 2. Looking at changing format for training
 - a. Possible weekends, evenings, expand more for others who cannot attend during the weekdays and those who have to be away from home for a long time.
Minimum of 14 and maximum of 22 for class size
 - ii. Transitions To Community- Grant different than Whatever it Takes Grant- Access funds to help with transition from AMRTC, extended stays in hotels, IPADS, etc. money can be used for.

- iii. AMHI Reform
 - 1. Changing application process for dollars, moving more to RFP based system like crisis grant. More competitive and “innovative”. This is for CY 2021.

- a. DHS Updates (Gloria Smith will not be making the meeting today)
 - i. Gary Travis- HASSAMI Grant Work coverage
 - ii. Sara Gable taking over path and crisis housing funds
 - iii. Ashley Spiegel started January 9th for other regions
 - iv. 434 BRASS Codes (other CSP’s) using old definition thru current grant contract period. Next application is due out middle of this year and will be another two year cycle. Questions contact Courtney Jones
 - v. Supplemental Services Support spreadsheet for clubhouse available questions Courtney Jones.
 - vi. RFPs Act evaluators, suicide prevention, cultural specific behavioral support and supported employment, residential crisis stabilization due March 20th.
- b. Innovation Grant update
 - i. Applicants who are being rewarded will be contacted soon (within a couple weeks). Not sure when they will be contacting others who did not receive this.
- c. Mobile Crisis Grant update
 - i. Hope to know in February if there was anything left over and could use the leftover money to make us more whole, don’t know anything yet on this.
 - ii. Still looking for a coordinator
 - iii. July, August, September looking for other funding
 - iv. Trying to make crisis a mandated service for the counties, which would make counties responsible. Would be an unfunded mandate.
 - v. 54% is county funded for mobile crisis in metro and in rural counties it is 4%.
 - vi. Can advocate by possibly attending COC meetings for coordinate entry system
- d. County Updates
 - i. Hiawatha Valley
 - 1. Bremer grant application to determine when the remodel and move will happen.
 - 2. Create a sexual harassment training for staff. Focused on clients who have interactions between clients and staff. This would be specific to residential programming and maybe OP therapy.

- ii. MNPrairie/SCHRC
 - 1. Staff enrichment, couple staff who went to training about “Bounceback Project” through Buffalo Hospital- Self Care. MNPrairie Book club from wellness committee
 - 2. Spoke on R20/MH Services in Jail committee and
- iii. Olmsted
 - 1. Wellness
 - 2. A lot of staff change, loss in management team.
 - 3. Law enforcement liaison position how to operationalize this. Megan Vogel is taking this position so they have to regroup re: her position currently.
 - 4. SU reform, trying to get a better understanding, ADAD may not be moving quickly enough.
- iv. Goodhue
 - 1. Hired for two positions. Ongoing CP case management and AMH position.
 - 2. Ran out of space in two years, trying to figure out layout of building
 - 3. Board very interested in ANOKA costs
 - a. Flood of R20’s, struggles with evaluators
 - 4. Working on wellness also
- v. Houston
 - 1. New intake Social Worker
- vi. Winona
 - 1. Difficulty with CBHH’s when they DNMC but no one will accept them. Looked into options for placement.
- vii. Fillmore
 - 1. Things are going well in Fillmore County, another ARMHS worker added in Fillmore.
- viii. Wabasha
 - 1. Hiring for supervisor position AMH, CMH, AP, CP and licensing
