1. Welcome/Introductions
2. Meeting Minutes approval
 - a. Winona and UCARE approved
3. Budget Update (Candace)
 - a. Budget modification completed
 - i. Completed submitted budget modifications for 2017
 - ii. Will send out final new budget by BRASS code and provider. Wants this back by the end of the month. She will send out information this week.
 - iii. Will be sending out budget submissions as well, have to spend it all by the end of this year. July and December will be the last two budget modifications.
 - iv. County can use any eligible BRASS code that they see fit within the 400's
 - b. Please confirm county budgets by May 25th
4. CREST Plan 2017-2019 (Tim/Mary)
 - a. Housing - Review DHS visit regarding bridging
 - i. Bridges program, our counties are eligible for the subsidy.
 1. Housing authorities should be aware of this, Tim will be sending out the cooperative agreement.
 2. Many counties did not know that they were eligible to have Bridges, how do we talk to our HRA's to ensure it is workable.
 3. MNPrarie responded to DHS RFP regarding Housing Resources Specialist. Olmsted has seen a benefit to this position.
5. Legislative Proposals-Crisis Center and Supportive Housing (Tim)
 - a. Workgroup Updates- \$45 million overall for these projects
 - i. Supportive Housing

1. RFP process
2. 25 beds in Rochester area 20 Rate Two and 5 that can be flexible with. Targeting those who have been at a SOS \$4.4 million spent by the region in the last 2 years
3. Purchasing property or having developer purchase property, who will be providing services
- ii. Crisis center-
 1. Three different types of models
 2. Charrette done- Kim Bretheim (sp?)
 3. Rapid access- tele health- crisis stabilization
 - a. 1st option: Adult and youth beds, no youth residential standards exist
 - b. 2nd option: Outpatient setting, still have children's component but form more crisis beds in other locations
 - c. 3rd option: no residential component, only OP services, easier to staff
 4. Visited Birchtree in Duluth, underutilized, location is key need to have access for users.
6. AMHI update from ITV (Tim)
 - a. Where is the sample MHIS report? Cortney Jones was supposed to send this but has not yet. If you don't get it by June 15th then let Tim know. Apps completed Sept. 14th, Contracts completed by Oct. 15th. Any 2018 underspending will go back to DHS for general fund.
7. Mobile Crisis (Tim/Candace)
 - a. Support through AMHI
 - i. Utilizing AMHI to support mobile crisis, can support with AMHI but must go through mobile crisis \$ first before getting other money. AMHI can only be used for the adults. Need to submit a budget by Friday for the \$875K they received.
8. SMI VS SPMI (Tim)
 - a. Can we utilize CSP dollars to support these individuals (SPMI)? The answer here is no. What are counties doing to support individuals who have anxiety issues?
9. June meeting with finance focused on BRASS codes (Candace/Tim)
 - a. Would it be beneficial in June for BRASS code updates? Group thinks that this would be beneficial.
