1. **Welcome and Introductions:** Rose Pappas called the meeting to order. Introductions were made.

- 4A. **Community Services Integration: Paul Fleissner, Director Community Services:** Paul presented on the Human Services Value Curve. Olmsted County Community Services is integrating work across all divisions. There is a different kind of future coming our way: 1. Non-traditional partnerships 2. Creative Financing Models – Investing in Social Outcomes 3. Analytics – Unlocking Data that Matters 4. Looking to the Outside 5. Integration – Wrapping Around the Whole Person. The CSI Teams Vision: 'Accessible and integrated environment of support and services.' Mission: 'Create a culture of shared ownership for the safety, well-being and stability of children, families and adults' Values: Person-Centered; Transparent; Innovative; Comprehensive; Inclusive; Continuous Improvement. Internal Strategic Priorities: Educate staff about work in other areas; Identify/ develop navigators; Database integration; Cross training; Crossover work with other divisions; Educational database i.e. Network of Care; Co-location of staff; Share pool of resources (funding streams) to create shared vision and ownership; Shadowing. Departmental Priority Goals: Operational Excellence: Integration; Sustain Effective Services: Housing; Effective & Innovative: Technology.
