II. TYPE OF REGISTRATION (Select one of the 3 options below and the applicable waste types to be collected/transported) **Note: This registration form is to register Self-Haulers of Solid Waste from commercial sites and to register businesses collecting and transporting construction and/or demolition materials, yard waste, contaminated soils and/or asbestos. Licensed Commercial Haulers are the only hauler type allowed to be engaged in the business of contracting with a generator to collect and transport Mixed Municipal Solid Waste (MMSW) and other solid waste from Residential and/or Commercial sites.** There are currently 11 licensed haulers that can provide this service in Olmsted County.

- Self-Hauler** from Commercial Sites (excluding Self-Haulers from Agricultural Sites as defined in the County's **Solid Waste Management Ordinance No. 10**): A Generator who does not contract with a Commercial Hauler, but instead collects and transports its own Solid Waste. A Self-Hauler **shall not** provide Collection and Transportation services to someone else for compensation.

**** Registered Haulers are only allowed to provide construction and/or demo debris collection and transportation services if the C&D debris loads are not contaminated** with garbage, cardboard, or other unacceptable wastes as documented in the Kalmar Landfill demolition cell permit. C&D loads must be allowed to be disposed of in a permitted Demolition landfill. If loads can't be disposed of in a demolition landfill, a Licensed Commercial Hauler needs to be contacted to deliver the waste to Olmsted facilities. Violations may result in penalties, suspension and/or revocation of your Solid Waste registration.

IV. DECLARATION AND SIGNATURES

I declare the information contained in this registration form is correct, to the best of my knowledge. I further declare the following:

- I will not contract to collect, transport, or dispose of Mixed Municipal Solid Waste and/or Industrial Solid Waste. A licensed commercial hauler is required for this type of service.
- Vehicles used by my business meet Minnesota Department of Public Safety Standards.
- Our vehicles will only use transportation routes with appropriate weight limits, given our vehicles' gross weights.
- Our vehicle operators have appropriate Minnesota Drivers License.
- If any of the above information changes during the registration term, the County Public Works Dept. must be notified as soon as the change occurs.
- I have submitted the required insurance information.
- I have read and understand the provisions of Olmsted County Solid Waste Ordinance #10 as they apply to my responsibilities as a transporter of solid waste.
