Paper

- Office Paper
- Newspaper
- Magazines
- Envelopes
- Mail
- Paper Bags



Corrugated Cardboard & Paperboard (Flatten For Recycling)



Aluminum & Tin/Steel Cans (Empty)



Glass Bottles & Jars (Empty)



Plastic Bottles & Containers #1, #2, #5 (Keep Caps On)



Milk & Juice Cartons (Empty)

For questions related to your curbside collection service, contact your waste hauler.

Never In Your Cart

(This is not an inclusive list.)

The items below are not acceptable in your curbside recycling cart. However, some of them can and should be recycled. For example, rechargeable batteries are considered hazardous waste and should be brought to the Olmsted County Hazardous Waste Facility. TVs, computers, and other electronic items should be brought to the Recycling Center Plus.
