

OPEN COMMENT PERIOD

The Planning Advisory Commission requests that all citizens who make use of this open comment period abide by the following guidelines so that the Commission may find the time of benefit to the individual speaker and to the Commission members.

GUIDELINES:

1. The audience member must be recognized by the chair.
2. The audience member must come forward, state their name, address, and the issue they wish to make a statement on. Please speak into the microphone.
3. The time cannot be used to continue a discussion on an agenda item that has already been held or is scheduled as a public hearing.
4. This agenda section is limited to 15 minutes and each speaker is limited to 2 minutes.
5. Any speakers not having the opportunity to be heard will be first to present at the next PAC meeting.
6. Citizens may only use this forum to address the PAC on a maximum of one time per month.
7. Matters currently tabled, in negotiation or litigation will not be discussed in this forum.
8. Matters related to personnel will not be discussed in this forum.
9. Questions posed by a speaker will generally be responded to in writing unless the PAC or staff can adequately answer the question at the meeting.
10. The issue to be addressed must not have been previously addressed at a PAC meeting or open forum.
11. The PAC shall not debate or discuss other than to decide how to handle the request or question. Where the PAC decides a response is necessary it may place the issue on the agenda for one of the next two regularly scheduled meetings.
