

Re-Invest in Minnesota Reserve Program (RIM)

The Re-Invest in Minnesota Reserve Program (RIM) is a land retirement program designed to protect and improve water quality, reduce soil erosion, set aside marginal agricultural lands and provide wildlife habitat under a perpetual conservation easement. This program retires land from production and returns it to natural, wildlife habitat. The perpetual nature of this easement program will have lasting environmental impacts in Olmsted County for future generations.
