### TEEN BIRTH RATE



**8.9/1,000**

### From 2014-2016 to 2018 Teen Pregnancy Rates among:

- 15 to 19-year-olds decreased by 26%
- 18 to 19-year-olds decreased by 26%
- 15 to 17-year-olds was not calculated in 2018 because the number of births was less than 20



2 out of 100 births are to teens

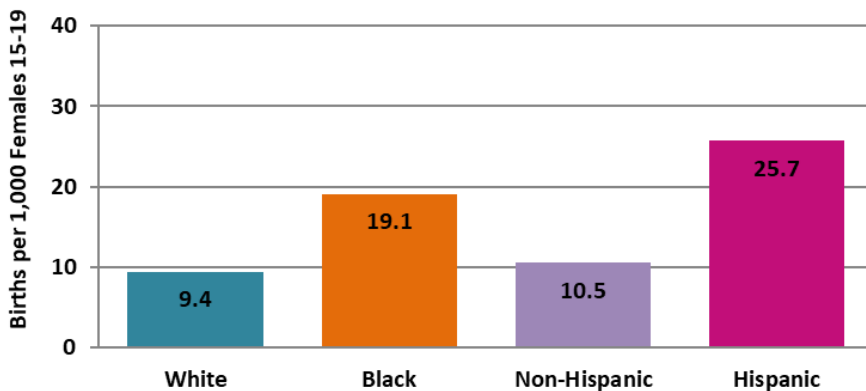


Hispanic birth rates are 2.5  
times higher than non-  
Hispanics  
(25.7/1,000 vs. 10.5/1,000)



Black teen birth rates are 2  
times higher than whites  
(19.1/1,000 vs. 9.4/1,000)
